### ◆ Academic Writing and Research Ethics3 (COV-7003-41 Prof.SungWug Kim)

[What is a pre-requisite subject? - It is a MANDATORY subject but it is not included in your total credit.]

- If you register other similar subjects, the credit will NOT be recognized.

- [Students enrolled 2016~2019] Master's & Phd: Complete in 2nd year, Combined: Complete in 3rd year

- [Students enrolled from 2020~] Master's & Phd & Combined: Complete before applying for final defense

- 1st year students are not allowed to register for this course.

- This subject will be open in Spring semester only.

### ◆ DOES Core subjects

[What is a core subject? - You have to complete at least 2 core subjects during your coursework period.

This does NOT mean you need to complete 2 core subjects every semester.]

- ESC5104-41 Organic/Inorganic Chemistry for Energy

- ESC5106-41 Thermodynamics of Energy Syst

- ESC5114-41 Electromagnetism for Energy

### ◆ DOES Seminar Course (ESC5179-41 Energy Distinguished Lecture Series I)

#### Credit and time table

[This subject is DOES seminar course. Lectures are given by external speakers every Wednesday.

The credit for this subject is 1 and it is a pass/fail subject. Energy Distinguished Lecture Series II(2 credit) will be held in Fall Semester.

This subject is not a CORE subject but it is one of the main subjects you need to complete.]

- For those who have already completed previous seminar courses may also register for this subject as it is a new subject.

### ◆ Energy Convergence Research I ~ IV(ESC5021 ~ ESC5024)!

[This subject is an individual research subject. You don't have to attend any classes.

It is not mandatory and your grade will be pass/fail. It is open every semester.]

- Combined: You may register up to 12 credits during your coursework period.

- PhD: You may register up to 9 credits during your coursework period.

- Master's: You may register up to 6 credits during your coursework period.

### ◆ How to adjust maximum and minimum credit for course registration

Section	Maximum Credits	Additional Credits
Master's (or Withdraw from Combined)	9 Credits per semester (No minimum credit)	NOT ALLOWED
PhD		Can take up to 12 credits for any 1 ~ 2 semesters
Combined		Can take up to 12 credits for any 1 semester

※ On your first semester, 12 credits is a default setting.

※ If you exceed 1 credit(e.g. 10 credit), it is also considered that you have already used your additional credit for that semester.
